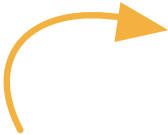




Is this document open in **Acrobat Reader**? Then you see a blue bar up here confirming it is certified and unchanged. Not us saying so. Adobe.



Now click **Signature Panel** (or the pen icon) and read this document's life story, entry by entry.

This document proves itself

Most software asks you to trust its claims. This document does not. Everything we say about NomaSign signing is verified, right now, by the software you are reading it in, checked against independently issued certificates and timestamps. NomaSign has no say in it.

In the **Signature Panel**, the list tells the story from top to bottom:

1 Certified by NomaSign Digital Signature

This seal was applied the moment the sender clicked send, before anyone signed. From that instant, only form fill-in and signing were permitted; any other change would break the seal and Adobe would warn you. Most e-signature tools only protect a document after the last signature. This one was protected before the first.

2 Form fields filled in

The changes that were allowed: the signer completing their fields. Nothing else.

3 Signed, as its own sealed revision

The signature is not a picture pasted on a page. It is a cryptographically sealed revision of the document. Expand it and Adobe will tell you: the document has not been modified since this signature was applied, the signature includes an embedded timestamp, and the source of trust is the Adobe Approved Trust List. Click "view this version" to see the document exactly as it existed at that moment. With several signers, each signature is its own sealed revision, and every later signer provably signed over the earlier ones.

4 A trusted timestamp closes the document

The final entry is an independent timestamp authority fixing the completion moment in time. Not our clock, theirs. This completes the PAdES long-term signature structure standardised under the EU's eIDAS framework, which keeps these signatures verifiable for years to come.

Why this matters: what changed, and when, is proven by certificates and independent time services that Adobe checks on your machine. It does not rest on NomaSign's word, or on a generated report page. The proof travels inside the file, wherever the file goes.

Signature. Sign this file yourself and watch a new sealed revision appear in the panel.

Every NomaSign document gets this treatment.
